and shall be read and construed as one with the Customs Regulation (Prohibited and Restricted Goods) (Consolidation) Order which is hereinafter referred to as the principal Order.

- 2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended in **Part II thereof (Restricted Goods)** as follows:-
- Amendment of Part II of Schedule.
- (i) under the heading "Inwards", by adding the following new entries immediately after entry No. 23:-
 - "24. **Used Tires** except under and in accordance with a licence granted by the Department of Environment.
 - 25. Lead Acid Batteries except under and in accordance with a licence granted by the Department of Environment";

- (ii) under the heading "Outwards", by adding the following new entry immediately after entry No. 8:-
 - "9 Scrap Metal from sources such as derelict vehicles, machinery, transformers, etc, except under and in accordance with a permit granted by the Department of the Environment."
