BELIZE JOINS GLOBAL EFFORTS TO COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE

Belmopan City, Belize. October 6, 2023. Belize takes a significant step towards combatting climate change by formally acceding to the Kigali Amendment of the Montreal Protocol. The Kigali Amendment focuses on phasing down the production and consumption of the hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), which are potent greenhouse gases widely used in refrigeration, air conditioning, and other applications.
